It was a great honor that Profs. Nan-Kuang Chen and Junne-Ning Hwang from National United University (NUU) visited the School of Power Engineering, School of Business Administration and Humanities, and Office of International Relations, Mongolian University of Science and Technology (MUST) on second half of May to strengthen the friendship and to extend the cooperation items between NUU and MUST, shown in Figs. 1-3. One of their important missions is to help found the alumni association in Mongolia.

The establishment ceremony of this association was held at the silver house (Mongolian traditional house) in "Chinggis khuree" tourist complex, Mongolia on the 21st of May 2015, shown in Figs.4.

This is the first Overseas Alumni Association of NUU.

About 25 guests, including alumni, current students at the dual degree program between NUU and Mongolian University of Science and Technology (MUST), and the two university staffs attended this ceremony.

Prof. Nan-Kuang Chen from NUU served as the founding chairperson. He addressed the alumni and said, "Improving the internationalization has become an inevitable demand for the National United University. I hope the association becomes a bridge that connects the university with the economic industries in Mongolia."

During the ceremony Mr. TSOLMON Gombo, was elected as the first president of the association. He was the pioneer Mongolian graduate from NUU. Last 4 years, he played a role of

coordinator for the dual degree program between MUST and NUU. Once he also received a certificate of appreciation from MUST for this matter. Now he works as a faculty member at the department of business administration, School of Business Administration and Humanities, MUST.

The origin of the cooperation between universities

In order to launch dual degree MBA program, B. Damdinsuren, president of MUST and Lung-Sheng Lee, president of NUU co-signed on Memorandum of Agreement on March 16, 2011. The objective of this MOA was to design/develop a collaborative graduate program between the universities

The program admits and educates undergraduate students from MUST letting them pursue their study in Master of Business Administration program at NUU in a second year.

The program will award a MBA degree by MUST and a MBA degree by NUU to the students who successfully complete the program requirements. All the courses are taught in English. According to the program curriculum, 24 credit hours of professional core courses will be offered by MUST first year, and 18 credit hours of specialized/advanced courses by NUU second year. While their study at NUU, at least one paper should be published and the students are required to write thesis in English.

Currently total 32 students graduated from this program. Employment rate is more than 70%. They work as mid or higher level managers in many different areas

2 graduates work for public sector entities such as Mongolian Railway Company and General department of taxation. 4 graduates work for financial sector including banking and insurance.

3 graduates work for a cashmere factory, 2 graduates work for chain restaurant businesses, 2 graduates work for medical equipment and supply company. Other graduates serve for a business magazine, mining company, construction firm and even for a non-profit organization. 4 students study and live in abroad. 5 students take care their babies at home.

Overcoming the borders of language and culture, in a second year NUU provided careful guidance in learning not only professional knowledge but also Taiwanese culture and the minds of Taiwanese.

Affiliated school of the partner university.

The Graduate School of Business Administration was founded at MUST in February 2015. Now all the graduate programs will belong to this school. This newly organized school is totally based on the resources and capacity of the School of Business Administration and Humanity (SBAH), MUST. SBAH has 56 years of history. Its old name was School of Computer Science and Management (SCSM).

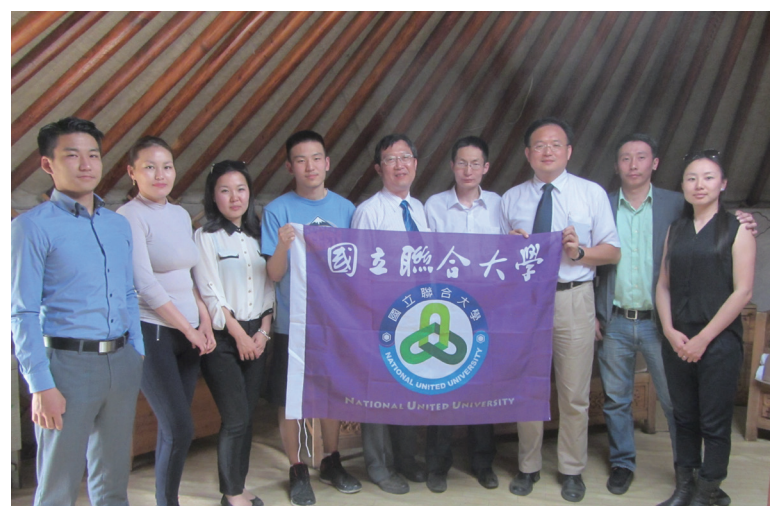
There are currently plans to build a network system via the Internet, where members can exchange information. We will hold the Annual General Meeting each year.

Hatta Yoichi has become famous in Japan where celebrity was lower than Taiwan. This is because publication of a bibliography and animated movie were produced for some years. Mr. Cheng began "skills in presentation" with a worse way. It noticed us not to make mistakes like too many words in one page. We learnt pretty much in this lesson. I am sure the skills will absolutely come in handy when giving a presentation during classes. Having been invited by us, Mr. Zhao shared the experience of "Save lives by old shoes" with us. Not until then did I realize that old shoes mean so much to those Africans in need. Seeing the process which they collected old shoes and clothes, I was thinking it would be great if NUU becomes the receiving place in Miaoli. Remedy learning lesson was popular with girls and boys. Mrs. Tong taught us how to make up step by step. Putting on makeup is actually a science. It needs a lecturer to guide you. I think I might still far from master to masquerade. As an international volunteer, we often get more chances to interact with foreigners. Mrs. Peng told us several manners, including dinning, greeting. Even a simple thing like shaking hands has to be aware of. When you get someone's business card, don't put it away at once. Repeat his name

first. Not just for being polite, it also keeps you from saying his name wrongly. World Passport is a company which holds English Summer Camp and International Volunteers. Our school is going to cooperate with them and holds an English Camp this summer.

Plan to invite foreign teacher and hire some of our students with outstanding English ability as teacher's assistants. Hope to teach through lively activities. It will be a wonderful combination with our university and World Passport.
